

# TEMPORARY RESIDENCE 23A/23E (POST ARRIVAL CHANGE OF STATUS) PROCESS MAP

## STEP 9: DNI & DEFINITE CUIL NUMBER ISSUANCE

The DNI card with definitive CUIL numbers will be issued and delivered to the assignee's residential address in Argentina approximately 30 days after RENAPER has been notified of the assignee's change of status. Both, the temporary and definitive CUIL Numbers should then be linked at the social security office, in order to unify social security contributions. Processing time: 4-6 weeks

## STEP 8: RESIDENCE APPROVAL

Once the temporary residence has been approved, an approval letter will be issued to the assignee. The immigration authorities will also notify RENAPER of the assignee's change of status so that their DNI can be processed. Processing time: 12-18 weeks

## STEP 7: CUIL NUMBER APPLICATION

Once the assignee obtains the provisional residence certificate receipt, the temporary CUIL number must be applied for at the local labour office. Processing time: 1 day

## STEP 6: TEMPORARY RESIDENCE APPLICATION

F&O I submits the Temporary Residence Permit application to the Argentinian Immigration Office. Upon submitting the application, the provisional residence certificate and DNI (National Identification Card) receipts will be issued. If the temporary residence is not granted within 90 days, the provisional residence certificate must be extended for another 90 days. The assignee may begin working after this step. Processing time: 1 day



## STEP 1: INITIATION

Client initiates the case with F&O I. F&O I assesses work permit category and sends document checklist to the client. Client sends the documents listed on the checklist to F&O I. F&O I reviews and reverts back with missing documents, concerns, etc.

## STEP 2: VISITOR VISA APPLICATION

Nationals requiring visitor visas in advance to enter Argentina may apply for visitor visas at the Argentinian consulate with jurisdiction over the area of residence. Processing time: 1 day – 2 weeks

## STEP 3: ENTRY TO ARGENTINA

The assignee and any dependents may now enter Argentina. If the assignee was required to obtain a visitor visa before entering Argentina, the visitor visa should be stamped at the port of entry.

## STEP 4: ARGENTINIAN POLICE CLEARANCE CERTIFICATE

The assignee, and any dependents, must apply for an Argentinian Police Clearance Certificate for their temporary residence application. Processing time: 1-4 days

## STEP 5: DOMICILE CERTIFICATE

The assignee must obtain a Domicile Certificate (valid for 90 days) from the local police station or civil registry. Processing time: 3 days
