

TEMPORARY ENTRY AS A PROFESSIONAL UNDER NAFTA

STEP 2: PREPARATION OF SUPPORT LETTER

FGI will prepare the submission package for the assignee's travel to Canada.
Processing time: 1-3 days

STEP 1: INITIATION

Client initiates the case with FGI. FGI assesses work permit category and sends document checklist to the client. Client sends the documents listed on the checklist to FGI.
Estimated Turnaround: 10-15 days.

STEP 3: OFFER OF EMPLOYMENT

An offer of employment must be uploaded onto the client's Employer Portal.
Processing time: 1 day

STEP 4: ENTRY TO CANADA

Upon completion of the submission package, the assignee can travel to Canada and apply at the port of entry. A work permit record will be issued and the assignee can begin working after this step.
