

TEMPORARY ASSIGNMENT (UNDER 90 DAYS) PROCESS MAP

STEP 2: VISA TYPE C APPLICATION

The principal applicant can apply for a Schengen C visa at the Danish diplomatic post in their country of residence or nationality.

Processing time: 2-3 weeks

STEP 3: ENTRY TO DENMARK

Upon receiving the stamped passport, the applicant may now enter Denmark. The passport with the endorsed visa should be stamped at the port of entry. The applicant can begin working immediately upon arrival.

STEP 1: INITIATION

Client initiates the case with FGI and begins collating the personal and corporate documents. FGI reviews all documentation and reverts back with any issues, missing information, etc.

STEP 4: POSTED WORKER NOTIFICATION

If contracted to perform services in Denmark the sending company and any individual assignments should be registered with the Register for Foreign Service Providers (RUT) online on or before the first day of assignment.
