

## WORK PERMIT PROCESS MAP

### STEP 10: ISSUANCE OF SECOND 06 MONTHS RP & FINAL WORK PERMIT CARD

If the security clearance result is negative, the assignee will be entitled to second 06 months RP and Work Permit Card. Processing Time: 2-3 weeks

### STEP 9: ISSUANCE OF FINAL WORK PERMIT

The application for Residence Permit must be submitted to obtain the Residence Permit Card. The assignee's presence is mandatorily required for 2 times for biometrics and receiving the RP.

### STEP 8: SECURITY CLEARANCE

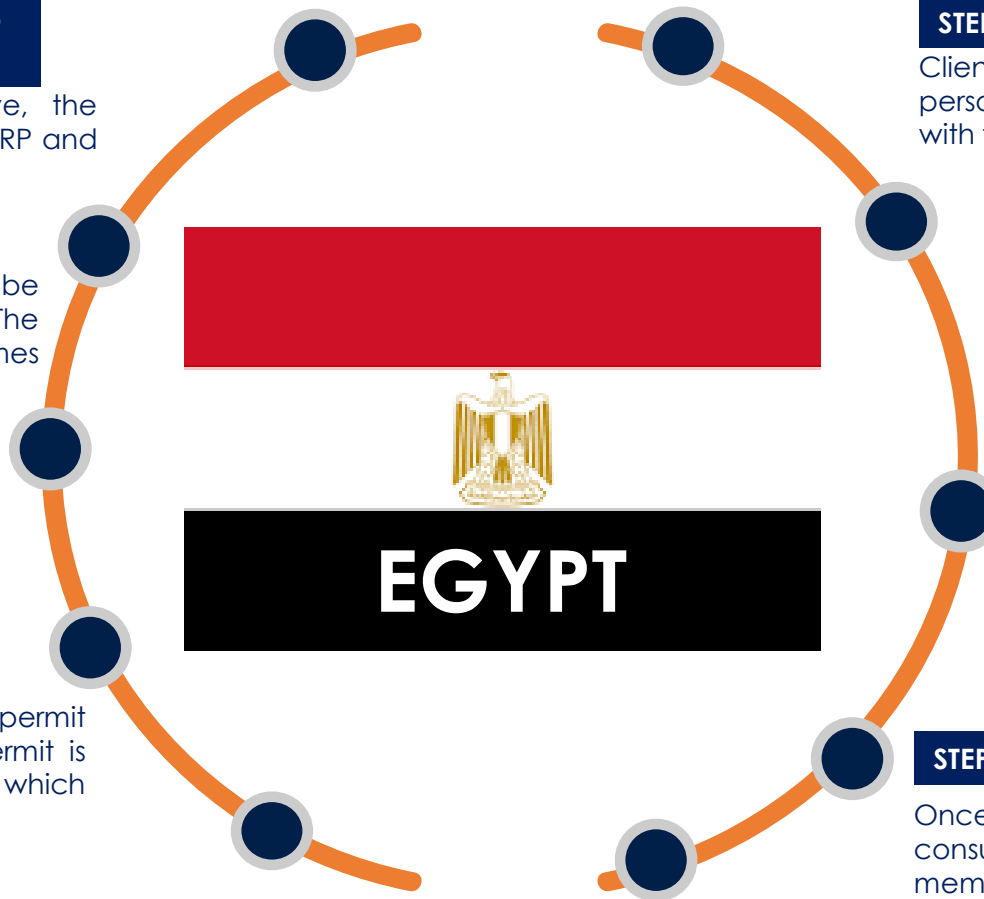
The final work permit is issued only after an extensive security clearance process has been conducted by the Egyptian authorities. Processing time: 4 - 5 months

### STEP 7: WORK PERMIT APPLICATION

Once the blood test results are ready, the final work permit application may be made. a temporary work permit is issued approximately one week after application, which entitles the bearer to commence work

### STEP 6: MEDICAL EXAMINATION

Within five days of arrival, the principal applicant (not dependents) must have a blood test to check for HIV. the applicant may not travel outside Egypt between the issuance of the yellow slip and the issuance of the temporary work permit, or the medical may have to be re-done. Processing time: 3- 5 days



### STEP 1: INITIATION

Client initiates the case with FGI and begins collating the personal and corporate documents. FGI reviews and reverts with feedback, missing information, etc.

### STEP 2: ADMISSION PHASE

FGI submits an application for prior to entry work approval to the Egyptian Ministry of Manpower before the applicant enters Egypt. Approval is issued in the form of a 'yellow slip', a copy of which must be sent to the applicant in order for him/her to travel to Egypt with the correct immigration status. Processing time: 2-3 weeks

### STEP 3: ENTRY VISA APPLICATION

The foreign assignee must apply for the entry visa at the Egyptian Embassy/Consulate in his/her country of residence. Estimated Turnaround: 1 -2 weeks

### STEP 4: ENTRY TO EGYPT

Once the Prior to Entry work permit has been issued, and the consular entry visa obtained, the applicant and family members may enter Egypt.

### STEP 5: LOCAL REGISTRATION

Applicants should register their presence at the immigration office (at their local police station). Note that this requirement may be waived for some nationalities and should be checked on a case-by-case basis.
