

EU BLUE CARD PROCESS MAP

STEP 8: TEMPORARY RESIDENCE EXECUTION APPLICATION

The applicant must visit the Migration Department to submit documents and biometric data, including fingerprints and photographs. The Blue Card should be processed with ten days (standard) or five days (fast track). Once the card is ready, it can be collected from the Migration Department.
Processing time: 1-2 weeks

STEP 7: ADDRESS REGISTRATION

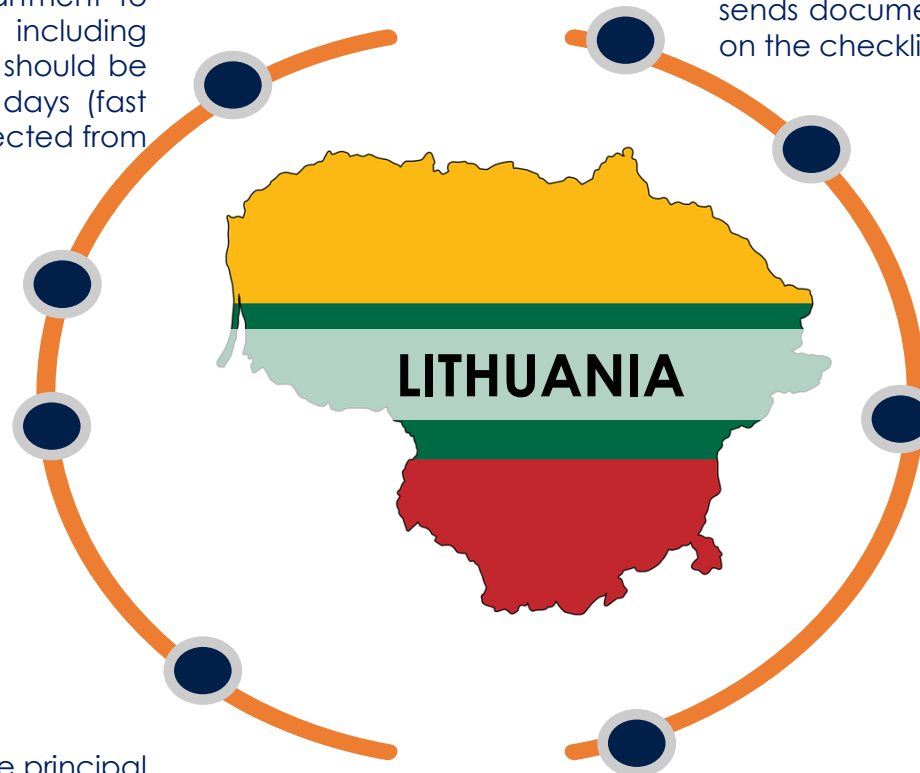
The applicant should register their residential address at the local Municipality Office.

STEP 6: ENTRY TO LITHUANIA

Visas should be collected within one month of issuance and used within the period of validity (usually 90 days) as stated on the visa. The applicant can then enter Lithuania and begin working.

STEP 5: VISA TYPE D APPLICATION

Once the work permit has been approved, the principal applicant can apply for a multiple-entry national D visa at the Lithuanian consular post in their country of origin or residence.
Processing time: 2-3 weeks



STEP 1: INITIATION

Client initiates the case with FGI. FGI assesses work permit category and sends document checklist to the client. Client sends the documents listed on the checklist to FGI.

STEP 2: QUALIFICATION EVALUATION

Applicants for any of the 37 professions regulated in Lithuania must apply for a resolution of a competent institution in recognition of their professional qualifications. Applicants for professions not regulated in Lithuania require a qualification assessment certificate issued by the Centre for Quality Assessment in Higher Education.
Processing time: 1-3 weeks

STEP 3: LABOUR MARKET SEARCH

If the salary amount is less than 3 times the average gross annual salary (or less than EUR 2,700 per month), and the occupation is not included on the official list of shortage high-skilled occupations, the position to be filled must be advertised with the local labour exchange (in the area where the Lithuanian entity is registered) for at least five working days, to verify that there are no resident (Lithuanian or EU) workers available with the relevant skills/expertise.
Processing time: 1 week

STEP 4: EU BLUE CARD APPLICATION

The applicant may submit an application for an EU Blue Card at the Lithuanian consular post in their country of origin or residence.
Processing time: 2-4 weeks
