

VISITOR VISA WITH REMUNERATED ACTIVITIES PROCESS MAP

STEP 1: INITIATION

Client initiates the case with FGI. FGI assesses work permit category and sends document checklist to the client. Client sends the documents listed on the checklist to FGI.

STEP 2: ENTRY PERMIT APPLICATION

The application for an entry permit is submitted to the National Institute of Immigration (Instituto Nacional de Migracion (INM) in Mexico.
Processing time: 4-6 weeks

STEP 3: CONSULAR VISA APPLICATION

Within 30 working days of the entry permit approval, the applicant can apply for the consular visa at any Mexican diplomatic post. Personal appearance is typically required.
Processing time: 2-7 days

STEP 4: ENTRY TO MEXICO

Applicant and family may now enter Mexico. Passports should be stamped at the port of entry and FMM entry cards will be applied at the port of entry. Once issued, the FMM cards must be kept carefully as they will be required for the post arrival residence card application. The applicant may begin working after this step.
