

EMPLOYMENT VISA PROCESS MAP

STEP 6: ID CARD APPLICATION

A final residence ID Card application must be filed with the local Directorates General of Civil Status. A sample signature and biometric information such as a passport photo and fingerprints will be taken at the appointment and the card should be created within 15-30 minutes.

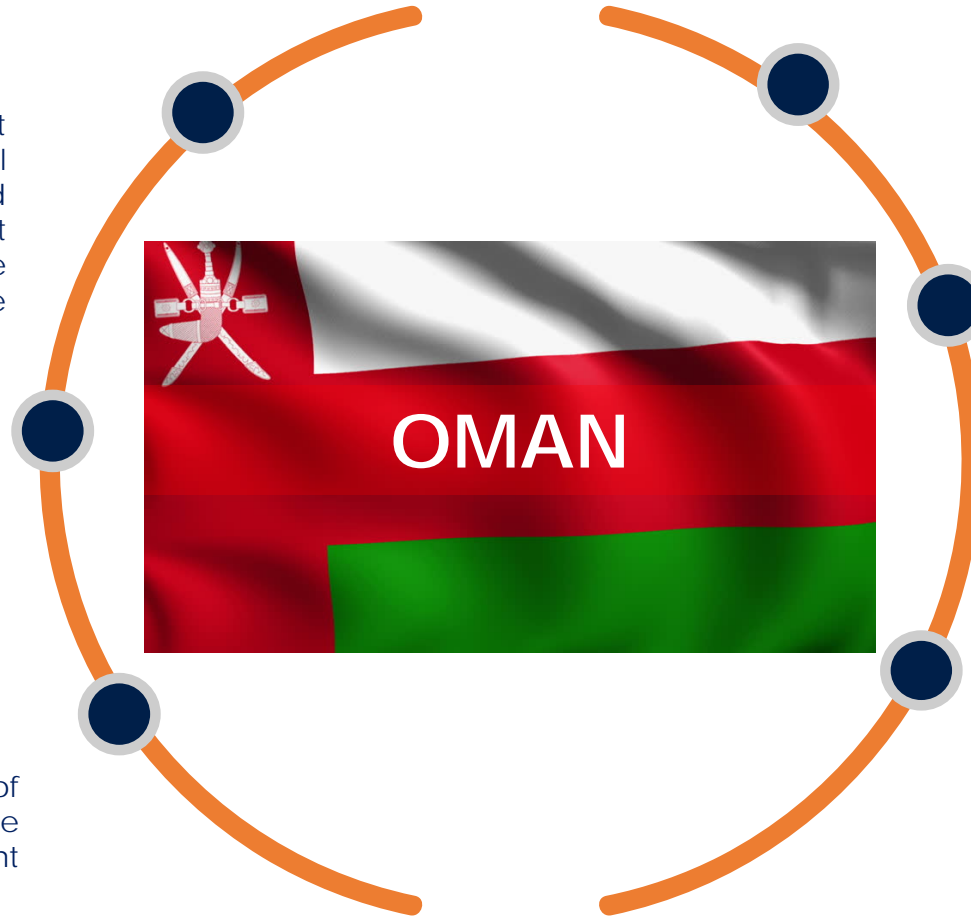
STEP 5: LOCAL IMMIGRATION MEDICAL

The principal applicant must have a medical examination in Oman at a designated clinic. The tests include blood tests for serious infectious diseases, such as AIDS, urine and stool samples and a chest x-ray.

Processing time: 1 week

STEP 4: ENTRY TO OMAN

The applicant can enter Oman with a copy of their employment visa approval, which will be endorsed at the point of entry. The applicant can begin work after this step.



STEP 1: INITIATION

Client initiates the case with FGI. FGI assesses work permit category and sends document checklist to the client. Client sends the documents listed on the checklist to FGI.

STEP 2: LABOUR PERMIT CARD APPLICATION

The request for the approval of a labour permit should be filed with the relevant industry department of the Ministry of Manpower. The approval will be granted depending on any quota requirements and will be issued for specific positions in the form of individual labour cards.

Processing time: 3-4 weeks

STEP 3: EMPLOYMENT VISA APPLICATION

The employment visa application form should be completed online and copies of the required documents uploaded. Following the online application the visa application form should be printed and the hard copy, together with the original required documents should be taken to the nearest Royal Oman Police (ROP) office.

Processing time: 1-4 weeks
