

LONG TERM WORK PERMIT



STEP 1: INITIATION

Client initiates the case with FGI. FGI assesses work permit category and sends document checklist to the client. Client sends the documents listed on the checklist to FGI.

STEP 2: JOB ADVERTISEMENT

The company in Barbados must satisfy the authorities that they cannot employ a local / national for this particular job and this vacancy must be advertised in both national newspapers - The Advocate and The Barbados Daily Nation

STEP 3: WORK PERMIT APPLICATION

Work permit application filed in country.
Processing time: 60 days

STEP 4: VISA APPOINTMENT

Once the work permit has been approved, the foreign national must apply for an entry visa at the consulate that has place over their jurisdiction.

STEP 5: ENTRY TO BARBADOS

Once the visa has been affixed to the passport, the foreign national may travel to Barbados.
