

VISITOR VISA WITH REMUNERATED ACTIVITIES PROCESS MAP

STEP 1: INITIATION

Client initiates the case with FGI. FGI assesses work permit category and sends document checklist to the client. Client sends the documents listed on the checklist to FGI.

STEP 2: ENTRY PERMIT APPLICATION

The application for an entry permit is submitted to the National Institute of Immigration (Instituto Nacional de Migracion (INM) in Mexico.
Processing time: 4-6 weeks

STEP 3: CONSULAR VISA APPLICATION

Within 30 working days of the entry permit approval, the applicant can apply for the consular visa at any Mexican diplomatic post. Personal appearance is typically required.
Processing time: 2-7 days

STEP 4: ENTRY TO MEXICO

Applicant and family may now enter Mexico. The immigration officer will place a seal on the visa. It is very important to ensure that the immigration officer completes this process. The immigration officer will then provide the applicant with the following link: <https://www.inm.gob.mx/spublic/portal/inmex.html>. They will need to create a profile, upload an image of the passport and download the "Electronic Multiple Immigration Form (FMMD)".
