

TEMPORARY VISA (CONSULAR APPLICATION) PROCESS MAP

STEP 2: TEMPORARY VISA APPLICATION

The temporary visa application is submitted to the General Immigration Department (Superintendencia Nacional de Migraciones).

Processing time: 3-4 weeks

STEP 3: TEMPORARY VISA COLLECTION

Once the temporary visa has been approved by the General Immigration Department in Peru, the applicant must collect the visa from the Peruvian diplomatic post abroad within thirty calendar days/ of approval notification to the Foreign Ministry. Personal appearance is typically required.

STEP 1: INITIATION

Client initiates the case with FGI. FGI assesses work permit category and sends document checklist to the client. Client sends the documents listed on the checklist to FGI.



STEP 4: ENTRY TO PERU

Applicant may now enter Peru on the temporary visa within six months of issuance. Note that the Andean Migration Card ("Tarjeta Andina de Migración") given at the port of entry or obtained online must be kept safely during the stay in Peru. The applicant can begin working.
